Who are the Dub Wheelers?

A Belfast based group of people who enjoy cycling for pleasure and fitness.

Who are the CTC?

CTC is the largest and oldest independent cycling organisation in the world with more than 70,000 members and affiliates. CTC is run by cyclists for all 22 million UK cycle users, working to improve cyclists' rights and safety on road and increase off-road access to the unique countryside found only in Great Britain and the Irish Republic. Why do we need membership?

As a group we (the Dub Wheelers) decided to affiliate to the CTC. The main motivation in affiliating is to have access to the CTC's 3rd party insurance cover. This cover provides up to £10 million third party cover with £0 excess while cycling in the UK. You are covered all the time, not just on club rides (unless cycling as a job – you are covered cycling to / from / during work). The Dub Wheelers will also gain organiser's liability insurance, 3rd party insurance for up to 5 unnamed guests during organised rides, access to CTC local group resources and a copy of the CTC "Cycle" magazine.

What is affiliated membership?

Affiliated membership to the CTC means you are a member of a club that is affiliated to the CTC. As an affiliated member you get a CTC membership card which gives access to many discounts and benefits, 3rd party insurance and a weekly email newsletter.

What more would full CTC membership provide?

Access to the CTC legal advice scheme and a bi-monthly cycling magazine.

What costs are involved?

£3 membership to the Dub wheelers plus your CTC membership.

What if you have an accident?

Once we have membership in place and we are covered, you would telephone the CTC accident line on 0870 873 0062 who will send you a claim form and proceed from there.

Am I covered?

Do not assume you are covered until you receive a CTC membership card.

Can I see the 'Cycle' magazine?

Yes. Just ask Gerry or Jonny or whoever has the club copy.
